

# Norcross First Baptist Church AWANA Club Rules 2011-2012

1. **Clubbers must obey leaders at all times.** (Clubbers include Sparks, Truth & Training.)
2. Please arrive on time (between 6:15 and 6:25 pm) to check in and take part in the opening ceremony.
3. **Please do not bring toys** (like yo-yos or footballs, etc.) **or electronic equipment** (like tape players or CD players, etc.) **to AWANA club meetings. Leaders will confiscate any of these type items and return them to the clubber** (or his or her parent) **at the end of club.**
4. Shoes must be worn at all times. (Tennis shoes are needed for game time).
5. Clubbers must be in uniform to carry the flags in the opening flag ceremony.
6. The Entrance Booklet must be completed in order to purchase a handbook or uniform.
7. Please treat others with respect: No hitting, punching, pushing or calling names.
8. Please **do not run** in the hallways or stairways.
9. Please **do not** play with or remove the items in the handbook-time rooms. (Some of these rooms are used for our weekday pre-school, before and after school programs and Sunday School.)
10. Eating and drinking are **not allowed in the gym, stairways, or hallways.** (If someone spilled a drink on the stairway or gym floor, it could cause a serious fall or injury) Please **do not** chew gum during AWANA.
11. Please use the restroom only during the refreshment break (or before or after the AWANA meeting).
12. **All clubbers must be picked up in the classroom by a parent or by someone approved by the parent. Do not leave AWANA until your parent or caregiver picks you up.**
13. **The AWANA "5 - Count" and "3 - Count" Discipline System will be enforced.**

# AWANA DISCIPLINE SYSTEM

**"5 - COUNT"**: This is used to quiet or bring to order an **entire group**.

The person in charge (Commander, Director, or Leader) initiates the "5 - Count" by holding up one hand and corresponding fingers while counting slowly and loudly to 5.

By the count of 5, all clubbers and leaders are to be quiet and are to pay attention. Clubbers are **not** to count along with the leader who is counting to 5. Other leaders count and hold up their hands and fingers while helping clubbers pay attention.

**"3 - COUNT"**: This is used when an **individual clubber** continues to misbehave after repeated correction.

**COUNT OF ONE**: A warning is given by any Leader to a clubber that he/she should stop misbehaving and he/she is being watched. The Leader giving the one-count tells the Director about it.

**COUNT OF TWO**: The misbehaving clubber is counseled by the club Director, who investigates the problem. The Director may elect to have the clubber miss the rest of club activities and/or miss the nightly team award.

**COUNT OF THREE**: The clubber is counseled by the AWANA Commander. The clubber's parents may be called, and the clubber may be sent home to parents.
